

) Interpretation Centre of Cala Lledó

Es Lledó gives its name to the dock from where watchmen, lighthouse keepers and navigators berthed, an old necropolis, and also the houses of a small livestock farm, currently used to welcome and inform park visitors.

In front of an imposing well, it is a magnificent balcony over the Andratx coast and the southern coast of sa Dragonera itself: "its jagged coves, the characteristic coastal shrubland and the flight of birds such as the Common linnet or Red-billed gull".

3 Es Colomer

A cylindrical tower built as a dovecote, although the "gossiping tongues" say that it was a hiding place for smuggling. From here you can see the reefs of Es Calafats, its European shag and, with luck, a Balearic shearwater.
