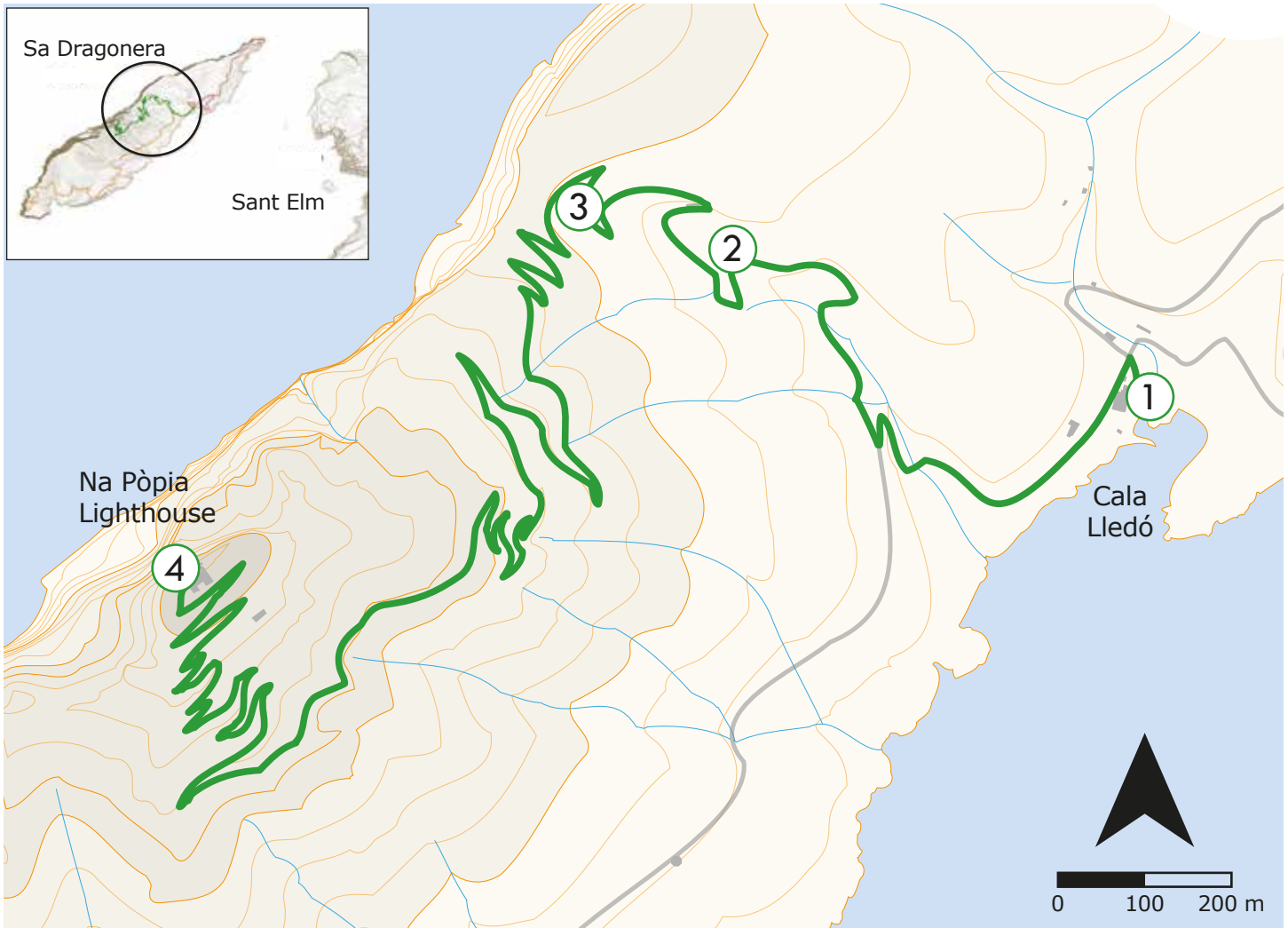

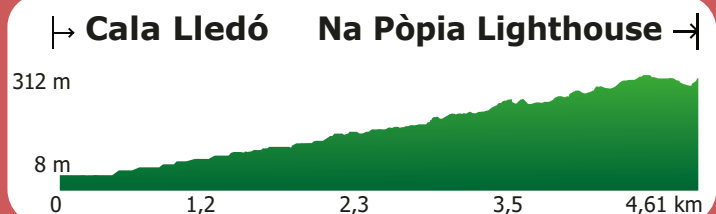

1 Interpretation Centre of Cala Lledó

Es Lledó gives its name to the dock from where watchmen, lighthouse keepers and navigators berthed, an old necropolis, and also the houses of a small livestock farm, currently used to welcome and inform park visitors.

2 Es Tancat

Surrounded by a "terrace" of dry stone, almond trees, carob trees and rotational sowing crops, which appear along the route. The Balearic warbler flies over these crops in search of seeds.

3 Coll Roig

A valley with a viewpoint that offers a pictorial view of the Tramuntana sea. It is one of the favourite spots of the Eleonora's falcon in sa Dragonera, so we invite you to bring binoculars.

4 Na Pòpia Lighthouse

Also called the Old Lighthouse, it was the first on the island and one of the pioneers in Mallorca. It is located on the mountain with the same name, standing vertically at 352 metres high over the sea. It is undoubtedly the best panoramic view of the island.
